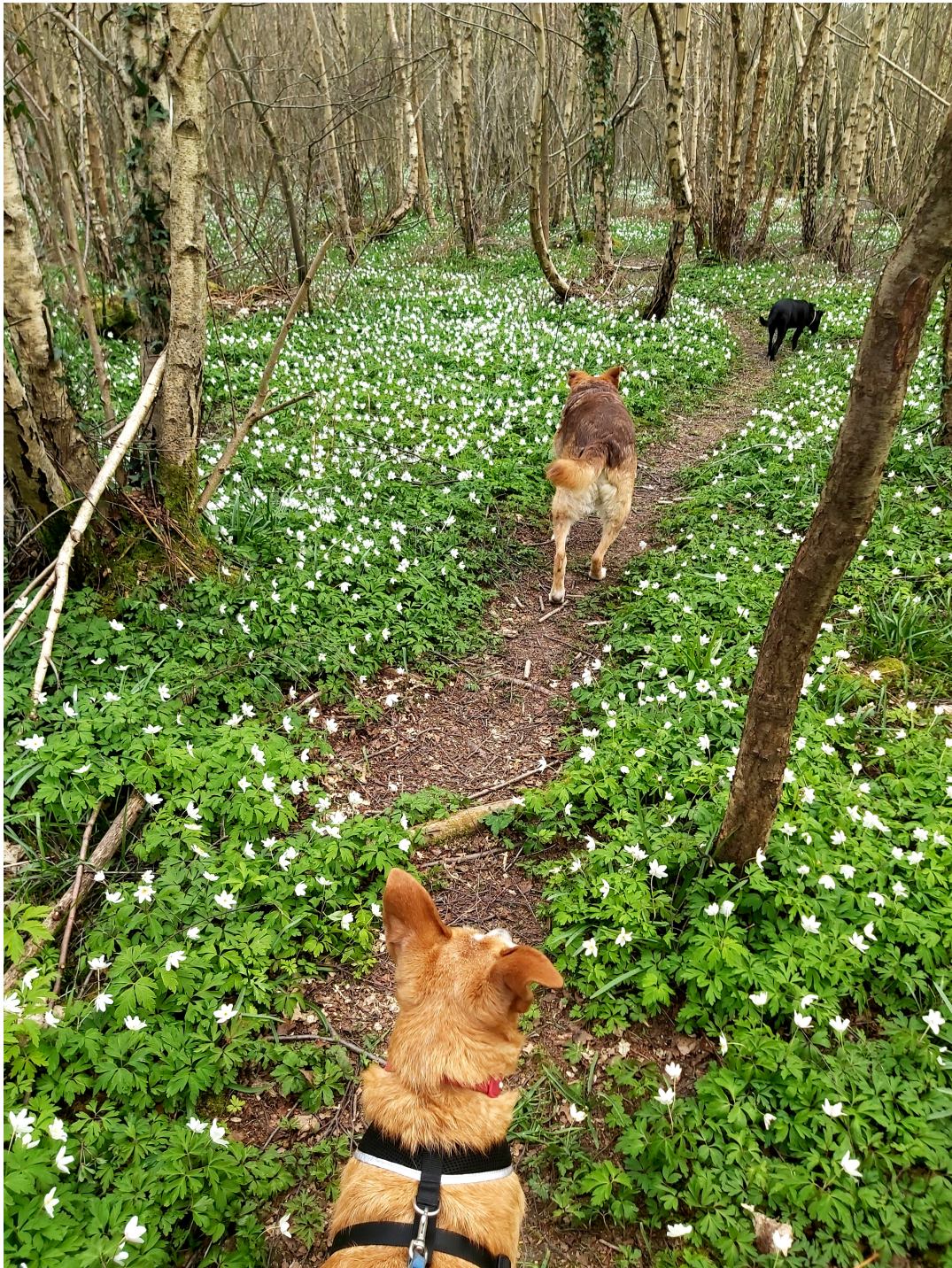


Sunday 5 April Day 7 of the garden journal
