Magazine advertising revenue recovered with no free months of advertising due to Covid. The increase in receipts for the magazine being £831.The Covid Thank You event took £90 for the Samaritans. £800 was received from the village hall, for tree work for safety reasons on trees on the boundary between the hall and the allotments. The council leases the land for the allotments and is responsible for the boundary trees. Finally, the tennis drainage works resulted in a vat reclaim for the year being almost twice as much as 20/21. the difference being £2,342. (-500+6633+4755+90+800+831+2342)

However these are not the only unusual costs for the year: Safety works to the trees on the hall and alotment boundary gross £1980; legal costs for the allotment lease renewal £1,136 and the cost of new host for council emails gross £594 and a slight increase in magazine costs for colour front page gross £922. However this has to be viewed against the following reductions in costs: Village maintenance costs fell by gross £372; play area repairs fell by gross £479; reduction in donations £1477 and no expenditure on noticeboards this year gross £2250.
